

CSHA REGION 4 TRAIL TRIALS

YEAR END HIGH POINT QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES

1).In addition to the California State Horsemen’s Association State Trail Trial rules, the following rules will apply to the CSHA Region 4 Trail Trial year end point program.

2).Riders must be a CSHA Region 4 member in good standing either by direct/senior membership, family membership, or be a member of a club that has CSHA membership(affiliate club).Have their CSHA dues paid and current .(NOTE)CSHA MEMBERSHIP RUNS FROM JANUARY 1 THRU DECEMBER 31 OF THE CURRENT YEAR. Or have an approved transfer request. Horse/rider combination **MUST** be signed up for the Region 4 Trail Trial year end program prior to starting an event for that event to count.(NOTE)THE TRAIL TRIAL PROGRAM RIDE YEAR RUNS FROM THE THIRD WEEKEND IN SEPTEMBER THRU THE FOLLOWING CALENDER YEARS SECOND WEEKEND IN SEPTEMBER.

3).Points shall be accrued **ONLY** at CSHA sanctioned Trail Trials in the division/category the rider starts their year in. Should a rider opt to change category or horse, points already awarded will **NOT** be carried over to the new category or horse. However a rider may request that their high point registration fee be applied to a new horse in that same ride year. Request must be submitted in writing to the Trail Trial chair.

4).Region Point riders **MUST** manage a ride, judge or assist in one Region 4 sanctioned Trail Trials **TO QUALIFY FOR YEAR END AWARDS**. Points to count as: ride manager (15) points obstacle judge (10) points Assist obstacle judge or other full day job as approved by the Region 4 Trail Trial chair (5) points. If you work more than one time per horse/rider combo you will have choice of \$10.00 off next region 4 TT event or will receive 20 raffle tickets at the event in which you judged.

5).Region Point riders **MUST** ride two (2) Region 4 sanctioned Trail Trials **TO QUALIFY FOR YEAR END AWARDS**. You may qualify more than one horse for year end points but your work and 2 minimum rides must be met with that horse as well.(NOTE) **ONLY ONE HORSE CAN BE RIDDEN AT THE SCE**. Your best five (5) rides if applicable will count for yearend high point awards. If applicable a different set of (5) rides will be counted for the **LOW POINT (SUPREME CHAMPION) AWARD**. To be eligible for the supreme champion award you **MUST** have a minimum of (5) rides. If you’re out of region rides are better they will be used in place of your region rides. **NOTE** region rides must be met for this to apply.in the event of a **TIE** it will be broken by using your best two in region rides plus your work hours. If still tied your scores from those two best rides will be used. For supreme **TIE** your placings from those 5 rides will be used.

6).points to be counted as follows. Divisions are 17&under, 18-49, 50-59, 60& over NOV, INT, ADV

1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th 6th 7th 8th 9th 10th 11th & lower placing

10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1 ½ points
